

**SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL**  
**(Abson Road, Wick) (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Foot Passengers,  
Pedal Cycles and Equestrians) Order 2021**

Notice is hereby given that South Gloucestershire District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended intends to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, foot passengers, pedal cycles and equestrians that length of Abson Road which extends from a point 75 metres north of its junction with Lodge Road in a northerly direction for a distance of 56 metres.

This order is required for the following reason: in connection with the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon water connection works on or adjacent to the highway. The order will be operative from 16 August 2021 for a maximum period of eighteen months. The closure however may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only when traffic signs are in position and only for so long as is necessitated by the works which are anticipated to be of **5 days** duration.

**Alternative route:** Abson Road, Naishcombe Hill, Church Road, Riding Barn Hill, Homeapple Hill, London Road, High Street, A4174, B4465, Shortwood Road, Abson Road and vice versa
